**115 Chardonnay, Giralan, Südtirol Alto Adige, Flora 2016**

First mentioned in historical documents in 1085 crisp and fruity 48

**116 Chardonnay Tormaresca, Murgia & Slento Regions 2019**

Aromas of orange blossoms, yellow apples, and white peaches. The palate is fragrant, savory and well balance 34

**118 Pinot Grigio IGT, Stemmari, Sicily 2019**

Rich floral aromas of magnolia mingle with notes of ripe citrus in this elegant and fresh wine. Best served with appetizers, pastas, soups, and seafood. 35

**119 Pinot Grigio Ramato, Marabelle, Terre di Chieti Abruzzo 2020**

Biodynamically and organically cultivated pinot grigio vinified with 4-6 hours of skin contact for a natural copper, rosé color and showing bright berry, citrus, and tropical fruits. A very delicious wine 35

**120 Pinot Grigio, Terlato Vineyards, Friuli Colli Orientali DOC 2019**

## RED WINES: PIEDMONT, ITALY

Bordering Switzerland in the northwest, Piedmont is the home of some of Italy's most regal red wines. Nebbiolo is the noble grape of both Barolo and Barbaresco, producing wines of great finesse and complexity. Barbera and Dolcetto from the area are also wines of notable class.

Currant, strawberry, cherry, floral, and leafy flavors are the highlights of this racy, elegant red. Balanced on the firm side with excellent length. WS: 92pts. 74

Medium garnet in color, aromas of red fruits and cassis complemented by hints of licorice, smoke, and caramel. The tannins central to the mouth feel, yet they are neither astringent nor tight... a perfect example of the Neive style. 75
- 305 Barbaresco, Casot DOCG, Nada Giuseppe 2018**  
Perfumed, full-bodied and elegant. Juicy black cherry, raspberry, licorice and crushed mint. made with organic grapes. WE: 96pts. WA: 92pts. D: 91pts 55
- 306 Barbera d'Alba Superiore, Brezza 2017**  
Fruit forward, cedar, and spice. This deep and complex choice is perfect for Zinfandel and Syrah lovers. 63

Undertones of cocoa and espresso with a classic finish and texture. 53

Dark cherries, licorice, tar, and smoke. Medium to full-bodied with high acidity and silky tannins. A very balanced selection with a long finish. Needs aeration. 70

Dark in color with aromas of earth tannins. With a warm, smooth finish 46
- 312 Barolo Cannubi DOCG, Brezza 2017**  
Classic Barolo from one of the best vintages in decades. Pretty, aromatic nose of flowers and spices, followed by flavors of small red fruits and minerals. Fine and ripe tannins. WE:95pts. 94
- 313 Barolo Docche dell'Annunziata, Renato Ratti DOCG 2016**  
Garnet red color. A delicate and persistent bouquet with traces of licorice, rose, and tabacco. Full flavored, warm and moderately tannic. **318 Barolo, “Pressenda” DOCG, Marziano Abbona 2011**

From the Monforte d’Alba commune of Barolo. Intense and ethereal aromas of dried roses, tar, and violets with notes of warm wood and spice. Full-body wine is comprised of fruit with a long, caressing finish. WS: 91pts. 100

**320 Barolo Serralunga d’Alba DOCG, Fontanafredda 2014**

An intense, clear-cut nose with overtones of vanilla, spice, roses, and underbrush. Dry, but soft, velvety, and full-bodied. Well-balanced, long-lasting on the palate. WE: 90pts. 94

**321 Barolo “La Serra” DOCG, Marcarini 2015**

Ethereal bouquet of rose, violet, and mountain flowers. Cranberry, cherry, orange peel and mint with finishing notes of tobacco and sage. JS: 93pts WE: 93pts. W&S: 93pts. 98

**322 Barolo, Prunotto DOCG 2017**

Prunotto’s Barolo is a deep garnet red in color. The nose is complex and generous with pleasing aromas of rose petals, red fruit, and spicy notes. The palate is full, well-balanced with velvety tannins. 95

**323 Dolcetto Dogliani DOCG, “Papa Celso,” Marziano Abbona 2017**

A single vineyard Dolcetto Superior from a 12-acre parcel. Complex aromas of dark cherry, cloves, and pepper. Karissa recommends. 65

**325 Gattinara DOCG, Travaglini 2017**

100% Nebbiolo. Undertones of very ripe fruits and dried flowers. Big and chewy, yet smooth and complex with a rich finish. David recommends. 68

**329 Nebbiolo, Corsini Langhe 2018**

Light spice and dark fruit with medium body. Soft, beautiful tannins and medium acidity with a wonderful finish. 48

**330 Langhe Nebbiolo Cordero di Montezemolo 2020**

Biodynamic/organic producer of historical note in La Morra. Perennial 90pts. 45

## RED WINES: TUSCANY

Although Chianti is the best known area in Tuscany and Sangiovese the most important grape, this region has far more to offer. Brunello (a superior clone of Sangiovese) is Tuscany's wine of greatest stature, producing wines of legendary power and longevity. The Cabernet Sauvignon or Merlot based wines aged in small French oak barrels, often called "Super Tuscans," give Tuscany another dimension with their powerful concentration and luxurious richness.

**303 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG,  
Costani 2015**

A historic producer, Andrea Costani calls this vintage one of the best in the history of Brunello. Cherry and plum enveloped by exotic spices. Decanting recommended D: 98pts. WE: 98pts. WA: 95pts. WS: 94pts. 160

**340 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG,  
Canalicchio 2016**

Full-bodied with fruit and raisins across the palate. Complex, yet smooth for its youth. JS: 92pts, WS: 90pts, WE: 90pts. 85

**341 Brunello di Montalcino Lisini 2015**

One of the greatest years for Brunello wines. Aromas of forest floor, ripe black cherries and smokey mineral tones. The finish is long and fresh refined tannins, balanced acidity. A wine very easy to love. Age for another 15-20 years. D: 96pts. WS: 94pts. WE: 93pts. 94

**342 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG,  
La Fortuna 2015**

Dark cherry and berry blends with notes of coffee, white pepper, and wild herbs. 85

**343 Brunello di Montalcino, La Gerla 2015**

Classic, traditional Brunello. Cherry, cedar, and spice with firm tannins on the long, perfect finish. WS: 92pts. 93

**344 Brunello di Montalcino, Gaja  
Restituta Rennina 2015**

Striking elegant aromas of violet, wild roses, blueberries & nutmeg. The palate is full of structure with firm tannins and a silky finish. Great one from the mentor Angelo Gaja 285

**345 Chianti Classico DOCG,  
Isole E Olena 2016**

Aromas of smoky black fruit and plum complement this medium-bodied wine with fine, delicate tannins. A nice, fruity finish with a twist of chocolate. 65

**346 Chianti Classico DOCG, Petroio 2018**

Deep, earthy Sangiovese with fruity notes of black cherries and firm, food-friendly tannins. 45

**347 Chianti Classico DOCG,  
Vignamaggio Estate 2015**

A beautiful, well balanced, and fruit forward choice from one of Tuscany's oldest wineries. Smooth with a silky finish. 45

**350 Chianti Classico DOCG, Riserva  
Marchesi Antinori Tenuta Tignanello  
2018**

Tignanello is one of the top wines made by the Antinori family famous from the 1500s with 26 generations of wine makers. WS: 93pts, V: 93pts. 79

**353 Fontalloro, Fattoria di Felsina  
2017**

100% Sangiovese. A fresh and chunky red that is well structured and balanced with chocolate and ripe cherry aromatics on the nose. A medium to full-bodied choice with soft, silky tannins, and a long, clean fruit finish. WE: 94pts, JS: 93pts. David recommends. 100

**355 Rosso di Montalcino DOC,  
Castello Banfi 2018**

Intense, fresh, and fruity bouquet of aromatics with typical violet, cherry, and plum undertones. Gentle, yet full on the palate with a long finish. 55

**369 Ca’Marcanda Vistamare, Gaja,  
Toscana 2020**

Vermentino/Viognier blend with generous bouquets of peach, apricot, and sage. Fresh, yet round, and remarkably complex. One of the very few white wines that Angelo Gaja makes JD:92pts. 110

**370 Costa Russi, Gaja, Langhe DOC 2006**

Elegant Nebbiolo with 5% Barbera from the Costa Russi vineyard in Barbaresco. Wild berry with beautiful background renderings of smoke and graphite. WE: 95pts, WA: 92pts, WS: 92pts. 300

**371 Darmagi, Gaja, Langhe DOC 2010/  
2015 - Last Bottle-**

“Darmagi” or *what a shame* is what Angelo Gaja’s father exclaimed upon learning that his son had planted Cabernet Sauvignon in their historic Barbaresco vineyards. Cabernet with a touch of Merlot and Cabernet Franc, another impressive, powerful, and iconic estate wine. 295

**372 Magari, Gaja, Ca’Marcanda, Tuscany  
2018**

Vineyard maturation has led to not only DOC recognition, but to the starring role of Cabernet Franc in the blend. Juiciness and concentration as well as elegance and drinkability are features of this vintage; a blend of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. WA: 95pts, JS: 93pts, WS: 92pts. 120

**373 Promis, Gaja, Ca’Marcanda, Tuscany  
2019**

Bright and fruity with a jammy nose. This delightful wine combines the elegance and suppleness of Merlot and Syrah with the austerity of Sangiovese. WA: 93pts, WS: 92pts, JS: 92pts, V: 91pts 90

**374 Sito Moresco, Gaja, Langhe DOC  
2018**

Roasted black fruits and roasted herbs with complex notes of cloves and finely tanned leather. A fine structure, graceful and stylish, almost gliding across the palate. 98

## RED WINES: CAMPANIA, ABRUZZO, UMBRIA, VENETO AND SICILY

Valpolicella is the name given to a blend of native grapes, of which Corvina Veronese is the key component, especially in Amarone and Recioto, since the drying process seems to bring out its best.

### **380 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC, Allegrini 2015**

A true classic of the appellation with its imposing structure and depth. Aromas of mature fruit and spices, this wine is sustained by the right degree of acidity and refined tannins on the palate. GR: Tre Bicchieri, JS: 94pts, WS: 93pts, V: 93pts. 120

### **381 Amarone della Valpolicella DOC, Righetti 2012**

From a family run winery established in 1904, this Amarone shows a classic bouquet of dried fruit and almonds with a hint of anise. Extremely rich flavors with a long, smooth finish. 78

### **382 Amarone della Valpolicella DOC, Villa Arvedi, Bertani Valpantena 2018**

Intense purple coloring with a deep nose and expressive flavors. Raisins, cherries, and wild berries create a full-bodied, yet approachable house favorite. 95

### **383 Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG Classico, Nicolis 2012**

Elegant and powerful wine with a distinct spicy bouquet and utterly distinctive flavors. Ripe fruit, jam, sensations of cocoa, walnut, tabacco and leather. JS: 94pts, WS: 91pts, WE: 93 pts. 93

### **384 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Vaio Armaron, Segero Alighieri 2013**

The Segero Alighieri estate is one with the longest historical, cultural and winemaking tradition in Valpolicella, dating back more than 650 years. Pietro Alighieri, son of the Supreme Poet Dante, bought the Casa dei Ronchi property in Valpolicella Classica, which remains the heart of the property today. Armen's Favorite 125

### **386 Palazzo della Torre IGT, Veronese, Allegrini 2018**

Rich, full-bodied with great concentration. A perfect complement to our traditional Spaghetti alla Bolognese. JS: 92pts 45

### **389 Valpolicella Ripasso, Tedeschi, Capitel San Rocco 2018**

Ample and Complex. Notes of cherry, raspberry and red currant give freshness to the wine, well-balanced, and well-structured. Alcohol and acidity are in good harmony. The wine is warm and round 45

The Demeter Certified Biodynamic and Organic vineyard is showcased by Alex Fullerton bold black cherry, blackberry, violet, smoke, forest floor, and Eastern spice. Poised and plush ripe fruit from a warm vintage. WE: 93pts, IWR: 92pts. 84

**401 Pinot Noir, Archery Summit,  
Dundee Hills 2020**

H. Steinman of Wine Spectator has called Archery Summit the “Rolls-Royce of Oregon for Pinot Noir.” Violet, plum, black licorice, powdered chocolate, and ground coffee integrate on the palate with a chocolate finish. JS: 92pts. 74

**402 Pinot Noir, Argyle, “Nut House”,  
Lone Star & Spirit Hill Vineyards,

## RED WINES: CABERNET SAUVIGNON

For many, Cabernet Sauvignon is the king of wine grapes, and the Cabernets from certain vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and other areas of California are among the very best anywhere. In less than thirty years, California wineries making Cabernet Sauvignon have gone from candidates to authorities, so that even wine makers in Bordeaux are studying (and copying) the styles and methods of California Cabernet.

In Washington's Columbia, Yakima and Walla Walla appellations, these "Bordeaux Varieties" are world-class. With the intense hot days and cold nights of these regions, the wines develop great fruit and structure. More and more Cabernets from Washington's hot arid climate are also attaining this high quality.

**510 Cabernet Sauvignon, Beaulieu Vineyard, George de Latour Reserve, Napa Valley 2018**

Aged in small oak barrels, this elegant wine has the structure to age and improve for decades as it exhibits complex flavors of black cherry and currants. WA: 94. 195

## RED WINES: CABERNET FRANC

Cabernet Franc is one of the major black grape varieties worldwide. It is principally grown for blending with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot in the Bordeaux style. It can also be vinified alone and is increasingly found in Washington, California, and Italy. Cabernet Franc is lighter in color than Cabernet Sauvignon with the same level of intensity and richness.

The first Cabernet Franc varietal wine released in Washington was by Columbia Winery in 1991. California, while perfectly warm enough to ripen Cabernet Sauvignon, produces some particularly rich forms of Cabernet Franc. The variety is increasingly well-regarded in Tuscany, particularly in Bolgheri on the Tuscan coast. We invite you to explore and enjoy our selection of this fascinating varietal.

### 601 Cabernet Franc, Browne Family, Columbia Valley 2019

Aromatic with cherries, roasted red peppers, and cedar. Lighter tannins make the wine refreshing and easy to drink with prominent flavors of strawberry and mixed fruit chutney. Savory notes and a hint of smoky oak on the finish. 80

### 602 Cabernet Franc, Casadei IGT, Toscana 2017

From the **organically farmed** vineyards of Stefano and Anna Casadei in southern Tuscany, 100% Cabernet Franc has explosive aromas of pure fruit and sweet spices. Layers of black fruits, leather, pepper, cinnamon, and licorice. Earthy and spicy with a hint of chocolate. 85

## RED WINES: ZINFANDEL

Zinfandel is a black-skinned grape indigenous to Croatia that made its way to Italy where it is known as Primitivo. The plantings there are predominantly in the heel region of Apulia. Sometime in the mid 1800s the grape made its way into California where it has become a mainstay of California's wine identity. Zinfandel is stylistically very versatile with wines that range from bright and lively to deeply brooding and port-like, depending on the soils and climate where it is grown and the winemaker's intention. We bring you an interesting cross section of our southern neighbor's offerings.

### **710 Zinfandel, Biale "Black Chicken" 2017**

This perennial favorite offers rich tones of mocha, blackberry, and cinnamon toast that are balanced by underlying acidity. It's a crowd-pleasing style that strikes a harmonious chord between fruit and structure. 75

### **711 Zinfandel, Saldo, NV 2020**

This palate is mouthwatering and smooth with a hint of chocolate. Sourced from Dry Creek, Siena Foothills, Sonoma Valley, The Talmage Bench, Lodi and Moon Mountain districts 55

### **713 Zinfandel, "The Prisoner," Napa Valley 2019**

A field blend, predominately comprised of Zinfandel with other old vine mixes and black grapes. This choice was featured as a two-time top 100 wine for Wine Spectator 2004 and 2005. 85

## RED WINES: IBERIA, SPAIN

Top quality, food friendly wines from the Iberian Peninsula have been recognized since at least the Roman era. Typically blended from indigenous grape varietals such as Tempranillo, Touriga, Grenache, Carignan and Graciano, these wines have a capacity to age long periods or to be enjoyed young.

In the 1980s, wine makers moved away from the traditional extended aging in old oak, toward a deeper, fruit-forward international style, using newer oak barrels and at times adding small amounts of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. We find these wines to be a natural companion to our style of regional cuisine.

### **745 Emilio Moro, Ribera del Duero 2016**

Cherry in color. On the mouth it is intense and mouth-watering. On the nose its richness and notes of wood, black fruit, and vanilla stand out. 68

### **746 Garnacha, Las Rocas “Viñas Viejas,” Calatayud, Spain 2014**

### **754 Priorat DO, Vega Escal Crianza 2017**

### **755 Tempranillo, Pesquera Crianza, Ribera del Duero 2016**

Intensely wild with grilled meats and perfumed musk layered atop notes of black currant and cherry. WS: 92pts, V: 92pts. 75

A prime example of an aged Rioja. Powerful, yet elegant, with a complex array of flavors. Delicate use of creamy oak and spicy, leathery notes combined with ripe bramble fruits and a mineral finish. D: 97pts, WE: 91pts. 75

## VINTAGE PORTS

Port has changed very little since its origins in the 1800s. The grapes are picked, crushed and fermented quickly. After about two days the must is fortified with neutral spirit, which arrests the fermentation and leaves some sweetness. While other kinds of Port are aged for many years, vintage Port is bottled unfiltered after only two years.
